

The children will be thinking about:

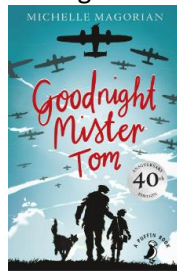
- Keeping/Staying Safe – Peer Pressure

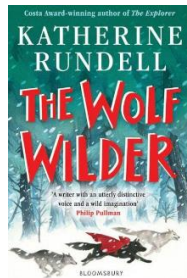
