








Please ensure your child comes to school with the following **named** items:

- **Reading Book and Reading Log** – please read with your child and sign their diary **at least 3 times every week**
- **Spelling Homework Books** need to be brought in to school **every day**.
- **Water Bottles** (containing water only please)
- **Coat**
- **PE Kit** - plain white, black or navy shorts, blue PE t-shirt with school logo and trainers. They will have PE on Monday and Thursday but please ensure that your child has their PE in school, everyday. **In the interests of your child's safety, it is essential that they have correctly fitting, suitable PE shoes. Long hair will need to be tied back and earrings removed (or covered)**
- **Times Tables** - please encourage your child to learn their tables and ensure they use Times Tables Rock Stars as often as possible. This is a very useful resource and makes learning tables fun.
- Sandymouth will be taking part in **Wild Tribe** activities on a Wednesday afternoon for Autumn 1 half term – they will need to wear long sleeves and trousers, have wellies and waterproof clothes (when needed).

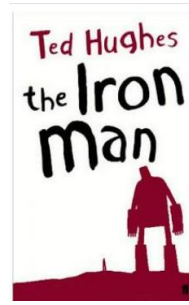
Curriculum Overview - Information for Parents and Carers

<p>Maths</p> <p>We will be working on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> € Place value. € Addition and subtraction. 	<p>English</p> <p>Some children will be working in their Read, Write, Inc groups continuing to secure phonics knowledge and develop writing skill.</p> <p>Some come children will be writing instructions based on 'My Strong Mind' and then a Non-chronological report based on Skeletons and Muscles</p> 	<p>Science</p> <p>This half term the children will be learning about 'The Amazing Human Body.'</p> 
<p>History</p> <p>We will be learning about World War 2.</p> 	<p>French</p> <p>Ice-creams!!</p> <p>In this unit pupils will learn how to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Name and recognise up to 10 different flavours for ice creams. Ask for an ice-cream in French using 'je voudrais'. Say what flavour they would like. Say whether they would like a cone or a small pot/tub of ice-cream. 	<p>Computing</p> <p>Children will be learning about systems and networks – Connecting computers.</p> 
<p>Art</p> <p>Children will appraise and create a final piece of artwork inspired by (not copying) the art of Banksy and Andy Warhol with a war theme.</p> 	<p>RE</p> <p>Children will be exploring what Christians have learnt from the Creation story and The 'fall.'</p> 	<p>PE</p> <p>Invasion games. PE coaches will be teaching the children for one of the two sessions.</p> 

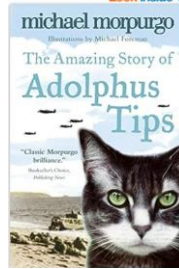
