










### Reminders!

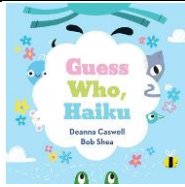
Please ensure your child comes to school with the following **named** items:

- **Reading Book and Reading Log** – please read with your child and sign their diary **at least 3 times every week**
- **Spelling Homework Books** need to be brought in to school **every day** – **children will be tested and new spellings handed out every Monday.**
- **Water Bottles** (containing water only please)
- **Coat**
- **PE Kit** - plain white, black or navy shorts, blue PE t-shirt with school logo and trainers. They will have PE on Monday and Thursday but please ensure that your child has their PE in school, everyday. **In the interests of your child's safety, it is essential that they have correctly fitting, suitable PE shoes. Long hair will need to be tied back and earrings removed (or covered)**
- **Times Tables** - please encourage your child to learn their tables and ensure they use Times Tables Rock Stars as often as possible. This is a very useful resource and makes learning tables fun. Please don't help your child with the answers as this will impact on future questions – they may then be too hard. Year 4 also have their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) in June – I will be sharing more information about this on 25<sup>th</sup> April at 3:20.
